To appropriate the sum of \$14,909,292 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$6,200,000 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,270,566 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$33,128 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1           Section 1. Appropriations. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$9,251,151 or so much  
2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of  
3 \$3,438,574, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund;  
4 and the sum of \$1,192,571 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United  
5 States Grant Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
6 2026.

7           Section 2. Apportionment. Operation of the Executive. The sums appropriated by Section 1 of  
8 this act are apportioned as follows:

7       Section 13. Administration and Allottee. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
8 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws. The allottee of the  
9 funds specified herein shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may  
10 be necessary, are used for the purpose for which are appropriated and that no obligations are  
11 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.

12       Section 14. Allottees.

13       (1) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 1 and 11 of this act is the Governor.

14       (2) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 3 of this act is the Speaker of the Kosrae  
15 State Legislature.

16       (3) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 5 of this act is the Chief Justice of the  
17 Kosrae State Court.

18       (4) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 7 of this act is the Public Auditor.

1 (5) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (1) of  
2 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Broadcast Authority.

3 (6) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (2) of  
4 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Island Resource Management Authority.

5 (7) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (3) of  
6 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Scholarship Board.

7 (8) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (4) of  
8 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae Visitors Bureau.

9 (9) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (5) of  
10 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council.

11 (10) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (6) of  
12 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Parole Board.

13 (11) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (7) of  
14 Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Price Control Commission.

15 Section 14. Reprogramming. Reprogramming is now allowed where the use of the  
16 reprogrammed funds would be inconsistent with the conditions or restrictions on the use of funds in  
17 the Amended Compact of Free Association and its related agreements or reprogrammed funds would  
18 be used for activities not specified and approved in the budget. Subject to this limitation, the

1           (1)     The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 15% of the total amount  
2 apporportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act either to or from any other numbered  
3 subsection of Section 2 of this act. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 15% of the  
4 total amount apporportioned to any lettered object class within a numbered subsection of Section 2 of  
5 this act to or from any other lettered object class within that same numbered subsection. The
